The objective	This lecture offers future language teachers and language practitioners a decolonial perspective on the scholarship of multilingualism.
Description of the activity	The lecture was based on how: (1) the Modernity/Coloniality/Decoloniality framework exposes the normativity of one-nation-one-language and one-speaker-one-language as fallacy, (2) the monolingual ideal has inspired a view of multilingualism as the exception, not the rule; as an impediment to proficiency in a single language; and as the co-existence of bounded and named entities (i.e. languages) alongside each other.
