The Indian Association of Teachers of French is a pan-India Association which was founded in 1953 to assist the teachers of French and to promote the teaching of French as a Foreign Language in India. For administrative reasons, the Association is divided in five zones: North, South, East, and Central - each Zone having its own regional committee. Activities such as training programs, workshops, webinars, contests, cultural programs and conferences take place periodically on zonal, national and international levels, both offline and online.

The Association is also affiliated to The International Federation of Teachers of French (FIPF) which has about 200 associations from the world over under its banner. The CAP (Commission Asie-Pacifique) is the Asia-Pacific arm of the Federation which includes all the Asia Pacific countries, as the name suggests.

This year the CAP has undertaken a project entitled « A travel to Asia ». This project involves teachers as well as students. The aim is to put together a 20–25-page travelogue of the source country through photos accompanied with brief write-ups/commentaries in French on themes such as gastronomy, culture, history and tourism and rich environmental attributes of the resident country.
