This issues of rationality, agency, hierarchy, and technology were addressed while imagining the near future and what all it may entail. Through the select texts (written and visual) the lectures pondered upon the question of being and its very crises. The primary aim of the lectures was to question the position of humans concerning the understanding of the planet. The lectures were followed by a Q&A session where the speaker clarified the queries of the students and briefed them about the scope of further research in the areas.

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
